TASTING NOTES

LOOK

Clean and bright wine with complex layers featuring ripe picota cherries tones and striking violet highlights.

NOSE

Its a wine with a high intensity aroma. Its fruitness stands out both ripe and fresh. Dark fruits like cherries, blackberries, black figs and prunes with floral highlights like violets and boungainvilleas. Herbs subtle tones like thyme and fine herbs. Toasted spices like cinnamon and anise, vanilla and wood compliment a high quality aroma.

PALATE

Warming wine on the mouth. Robust and mature tannings give a full-bodied wine. Mouth aroma reminiscent of the nose intensifying the flavor of dark fruits, dairies, spices notes (vanilla, cinnamon, clove and black pepper), dark chocolate and oak. A well-balanced wine with a long and elegant finish.
