MONTE XANIC CALIXA CABERNET SAUVIGNON — SYRAH 2021

DESCRIPTION

A classic new-world blend of two bold grapes, showcasing the Valle de Guadalupe terroir with its sun drenched vineyards and granite soils. This is a bountiful wine with flavors of ripened blackberries, tart Bing-cherries and a subtle floral note of violets & fragrant lilacs. Truly a delicious crowd pleaser with or without food.



VARIETAL(S)

80% Cabernet Sauvignon
and 20% Syrah.

AGING

French oak barrels.

PAIRING

Excellent accompaniment to roast beef, hamburgers, pizzas, enchiladas, carnitas, brie cheese, young manchego cheese & serrano ham. Very versatile wine.

VINEYARD

Valle de Ojos Negros and Valle de Guadalupe.

TASTING NOTES

A limpid wine with medium-layer violet tones and deep cherry color.

· NOSE

It is a medium body wine, with fresh aromatics of high intensity. Very expressive with notes of black fruits such as blackberries, Bing cherries and black currant. Floral notes of lilacs, violets followed by a hint of toasted oak. Spice like black pepper, cinnamon and vanilla.

· PALATE

Dry on the palate with fresh acidity. Dense and chewy. A truly delicious crowd pleaser. Well-balanced with a long persistent finish. The tannins are delicate and silky.

Alcohol content: 13.8% **Harvest Date:** September-October 2020 **Harvest sugar:** 22-24 Brix **Bottling date:** January 2022 **Residual sugar:** 0.58 g/L

Total acidity: 5.55 g/L **PH:** 3.80 **Extra enological techniques:** Two daily pump-overs 2/3 of fermentation (also with delestage) then only one. No fining.

Fermentation: In stainless steel tanks for 10-15 days at 75°F, then maceration for one week, racked off gross lees to add malolactic bacteria.
